Kansas City Public Library Board of Trustees Special Meeting – September 28, 2017

J. Kemper called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

J. Kemper opened the public hearing for the 2017 amended property tax rate and the revised 2017 - 2018 budget and asked for questions and comments. There was no response from the public and J. Kemper closed the public hearing.

Discussing the proposed amended ad valorem tax rate and corrected assessed value received from Jackson County, Siragusa stated that Library staff recommended that the ad valorem tax rate for 2017 be set at 46.76 cents per assessed \$100 valuation.

Motion by Dixon to approve the recommendation of the Chief Executive to fix the Library's 2017 ad valorem tax rate at 46.76 cents per \$100 assessed valuation pursuant to the provisions of 67.110 RSMo. Second by Bell. Approved unanimously. (LBM 4228)

Siragusa explained the proposed revised 2017-2018 Library Operating Budget increased by \$7,000. The budget increase was applied to salary expense to support the recent minimum wage pay increase for Library employees.
