Perkins-McGuinness gave a brief review of the plans for the 150th Anniversary Celebration. The group discussed the timeline for events and activities, plans for stakeholder involvement, clarification of goals and metrics, and plans for tie-ins to the Library's rebranding and strategic initiatives which will be underway at the same time.

Discussing ideas for creating a big splash during the actual anniversary week in December 2023, Browne suggested a community luncheon with a proclamation from Mayor Lucas or Congressman Cleaver. Kemper suggested asking Crosby Kemper III for recommendations for a keynote speaker to highlight the civilizational role of libraries.

Discussing goals and metrics, Oñate-Greim suggested that one of the goals should be to increase patronship and focus on informing the community on the resources the Library offers. Snell asked
