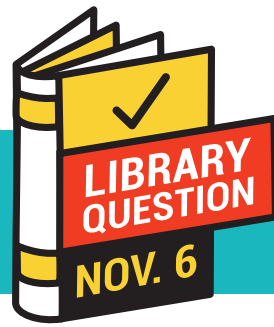

The Library is proposing an 8-cent increase in its property tax-based operating levy for the purpose of upgrading its facilities and sustaining its collections and expansive menu of services for the public.

Opened after the Library's last levy increase in 1996, the Sugar Creek Branch serves the city of Sugar Creek and the Fairmont area of Independence.
